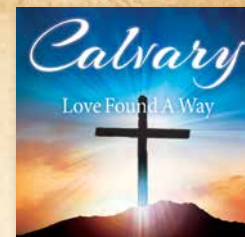
“Our topics will include all aspects of the sanctuary, the significance in each piece of furniture, and the work of the priests. We’ll look at the significance of

EXTREME MESSAGE



After retiring in 2006, Rick and Judy Hayes moved to Kimberling City, Missouri, just south of the Branson resort area. While members of the Plantation Seventh-day Adventist Church in Florida, they were in charge of the audio-visual department, so when they retired, they both had thoughts of running a radio station. However, as things often go, those thoughts were superseded by “life happening.”

No Sleep

After about seven years, something strange began happening. “I couldn’t sleep one night,” Rick says, “so I told the Lord, ‘You must want to talk to me, so I guess I better get up and listen.’”

As he sat in another room, quietly praying, he was impressed that their church needed to build a radio station. *A radio station?* Rick thought.

Lord, this is a 22-member church in a small town where almost everybody has gray hair!

He tried to ignore God’s voice, thinking it might be his own personal desire for a radio station pushing through. But God kept him up for three weeks with the same message every night!

Rick says he’d only been a “pew warmer” until then, but finally, he decided to bring the idea to the church. So on a Sabbath morning, he stood up and told them what the Lord had impressed upon him, along with all the pertinent facts about filing for a permit.

The church members were shocked at the thought, but even more surprised when a visitor in the front row stood up and confirmed everything Rick had told them. Mickey Burkett was visiting his father that week, and just happened to operate a 3ABN Radio affiliate station KSDQ 88.7 FM in Moberly, Missouri. As they talked, he gave Rick guidance on how to proceed with the Federal Communications Commission application process.

Overcoming Difficulties

Their first application was denied because another local group received

one more favorable point than they did. However, they were informed they could apply for another frequency, and when they did, it was granted. Unfortunately, the permit called for a tower on a neighbor’s property, so they filed and received a modification with an expiration date of June 2016.

In February 2015 they submitted their request for a tower permit to the county building inspector and raised the money for it while they waited. By August, they’d purchased the tower and were ready to install it, but when they showed up to get their permit, they were told they hadn’t given the county enough information.

After providing this, they were told to go to the Planning and Zoning Department for their permit. It was approved, but then they were told they had to bring it to the City Council meeting

for a vote! The next meeting was a month later—putting them into October, and because of other technicalities, the process dragged out until the December meeting, but their permit *was granted!*

Xtreme Message

The Lord provided a mild winter, so they were able to break ground in February, and finally, KCXM-LP 95.1 FM went on the air on March 21, 2016.

Their call letters stand for Kimberling City Xtreme Message, “because these days, everything with the young people is *extreme*. We’ve got to catch their attention!” Rick says with a smile.

BRINGING GOOD NEWS TO HOUSTON, TEXAS

When I heard that the Federal Communications Commissions (FCC) was going to open a window of time to file for new Low Power FM (LPFM) radio station in 2013, I wondered if any of our Spanish-speaking brethren would be interested in applying for a license and become a 3ABN Latino Radio affiliate.

I didn't wonder for very long, though, because the Lord answered my prayer with a call from Pastor Miguel Huizzi, asking for more information about how much territory an LPFM radio station covered, how much it would cost to build one, and if anyone could apply.



John Dinzey is the general manager for 3ABN Latino Network. Originally from the Dominican Republic, his passion is to preach the gospel. His wife, Idalia, works with him at 3ABN Latino, and they've been blessed with two wonderful sons, Samuel and Caleb.

When he first called, Pastor Huizzi didn't feel his English language comprehension was sufficient to talk directly to our 3ABN Radio staff, so I had the privilege of assisting him. I am grateful to our knowledgeable 3ABN Radio staff for their excellent support. When I didn't know the answer to his question, they always had the information we needed.

PREPARED IN ADVANCE

God began preparing Pastor Huizzi long before the FCC window was even announced. In January 2011, he and his wife registered their new ministry, called, *Ministério de 4ABN*, (The Fourth Angel Broadcasting Network) in a Houston court.

In October 2013, they filed their application for an LPFM construction permit, and in reality, there could have been dozens or even a few hundred applications for the same frequency. But on November 5, good news arrived in a letter from the FCC, indicating a permit had been granted to build 4ABN Radio in Houston. Praise the Lord!

REACHING OUT IN HOUSTON

Pastor Huizzi states, "When we faced the challenge to find an engineer that could guide and instruct us, who had the capacity, knowledge, and ability to help us with the installation, we called 3ABN. They kindly referred us to an engineer named Stephen Denny, whom we appreciate and admire because he is a brother in Christ, and a man that is committed to the work of the Lord.

"On November 22, 2015, the installation was completed, and Stephen Denny and his wife Rosa joined my wife Carmen Julia and me to pray for the Lord's blessings on the radio station. Then, at 2:25 p.m., we launched 4ABN's KOYM-LP 99.7 F.M. on the air in Houston, Texas!"

Pastor Huizzi continues, "To inform area church members about 4ABN Radio, we organized an inauguration day on March 12 of this year, with our special guests, Pastor Carlos Craig, president of the Texas Conference of Seventh-day Adventists; Pastor Joel Medina, assistant director and producer of radio and television programs for *La Voz de la Esperanza* (The Voice of Hope); and John Dinzey, general manager of 3ABN Latino."

4ABN Radio is broadcasting as many hours of 3ABN Latino Radio Network as possible, along with their locally produced programs. It was an inspiring moment to be a part of the inauguration ceremonies for this radio station. Please remember them in your prayers today, asking God to supply their every need, and that He use this radio station as an instrument in His hands to bring the good news of salvation to hundreds and thousands in the Houston area. ☺

When you think of Father's Day, what comes to your mind? Do you have warm recollections of special times with your dad? Or do you have memories of a harsh, gruff, near-stranger who you wish hadn't been your father?

Perhaps you don't even know who or where he is. This is the perplexing situation that affects many in the inner city.

For those of us who have been blessed with great fathers, it's hard to relate to; and yet, it is a statistical reality for

many. More than 20 million children live in a home without the physical presence of a father.

The Ugly Truth

It's been said that if it were classified as a disease, fatherlessness would be an epidemic worthy of attention as a national emergency!

According to the website of the National Center for Fathering, children from fatherless homes are almost four times more likely to be poor, and run a dramatically greater risk of drug and alcohol abuse, dropping out of school, and suffering from health and emotional problems. Boys are more likely to become involved in crime, and girls more prone to become pregnant teens. In addition, children born to single mothers demonstrate higher levels of aggressive behavior than children born to married mothers.

Fatherless students account for 71 percent of high school dropouts, and have more trouble academically, scoring poorly on tests of reading, math, and critical thinking skills.

The same website stated that in the National Longitudinal Study of Adolescent Health, researchers discovered a direct correlation between the absence of fathers and incidents of teen violence. The fewer the fathers, the more teen acts of violence.

One inner city teacher told a story about one of her kindergarten students. Her students were poor, and most lived in run-down neighborhoods. The school served a free breakfast and lunch everyday to kids who otherwise might have gone for days without a solid meal.

Thirst Quencher

When the sports drink manufacturer came up with the slogan, “Obey Your Thirst” it really caught on. Gatorade became the sports enthusiast’s drink. Following the trend, soon other “thirst quenching” drinks hit the convenience stores. Sports drinks are now projected to be a \$10.6 billion dollar industry by 2017, according to a 2013 article written by Brian War-moth, of fooddive.com.

The thought that came to mind when I read this article was, *How much would Gatorade make if they gave their product away for free? Is quenching our thirst the focus that drives their market projections?* I don’t want to make an uncertain judgment call, but I think money is surely a driving factor.

So what was the driving factor when Jesus met the woman at the well? A most powerful lesson is communicated during

His exchange with the Samaritan woman. “Let’s go to the videotape!”

“So He came to a city of Samaria which is called Sychar, near the plot of ground that Jacob gave to his son Joseph. Now Jacob’s well was there. Jesus therefore, being wearied from His journey, sat thus by the well. It was about the sixth hour. A woman of Samaria came to draw water. Jesus said to her, ‘Give Me a drink.’” John 4:5–7.

Her immediate response tells us she placed more emphasis on her national origin than her spiritual destiny. “Then the woman of Samaria said to Him, ‘How is it that You, being a Jew, ask a drink from me, a Samaritan woman?’ For Jews have no dealings with Samaritans.” John 4:9.

Thinking of our upcoming evangelistic event this fall, I imagine that with the teeming ethnic diversity of London,

national origin might become a roadblock to introducing people to their spiritual destiny. We might hold committee meetings to think of the “best approach” to reach such a diverse cross section. We might consider the most recent census, thinking that information is power. We might even hold surveys to decide how to calibrate our evangelistic thrust.

But while you take all of that into consideration, consider the skillful tenacity of the Master: “Jesus answered and said to her, ‘If you knew the gift of God, and who it is who says to you, “Give Me a drink,” you would have asked Him, and He would have given you living water.’” John 4:10.

The Gift

Evangelism is not just a series of meetings on various topics. It’s not an endless round of lessons, invitations, and clever slogans. It’s focusing on the Gift, and Jesus’ life is replete with titles that remind us of the heaven-sent Gift He is.

Jesus is the Rose of Sharon, the Lily of the Valley, and the Oil of Gladness, just to name a few, and who would refuse a Rose,

a Lily, and bottle of fragrant Oil? When we present Jesus as the Gift that He is, hearts will be softened. When we exalt Him as the only one who can change the humdrum of our daily routines into an exciting, life-fulfilling journey, He will be impossible to resist.

Like the Samaritan woman, many return day after day to the well that never satisfies. We are called to present Jesus in such an appealing manner that the masses in London will say, “Sir, give me this water, that I may not thirst, nor come here to draw.” John 4:15.

However, we must have a daily encounter with this same Jesus. Only then can we offer Him as the water that brings eternal satisfaction. “He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.” John 7:38. ☉

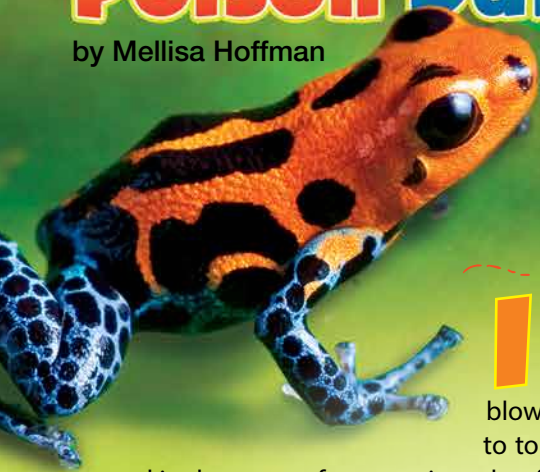

Poison Dart Frogs

Bible Verse:

“But God chose the foolish things of the world to shame the wise; God chose the weak things of the world to shame the strong.”
1 Corinthians 1:27 (NIV)

Imagine yourself in the jungle of South America. You watch as a tribal hunter inserts a dart into his blowgun. The hunter is very careful not to touch the sharp tip of the dart as it is covered in the venom from a poison dart frog. If any of the poison were to get on his skin, the hunter knows he would not survive very long.

Over one hundred different species of poison dart frogs exist, each one decorated in some of the most beautiful colors you could ever see—vibrant hues of yellow, gold, red, green, and blue, just to name a few. But looking at them is the only safe thing to do. Predators know that those bright colors are a sign of danger, so for the most part, these frogs live a peaceful life. Because they excrete poison through their skin, many animals can become extremely sick by just licking one of these deadly frogs. In fact, the frog only has one natural predator—a fire-bellied snake that is immune to the toxic poison.

You would expect such a poisonous frog to be fairly large, but surprisingly most of them are less than an inch in length. The smallest one is called the Mount Iberia frog and is about 10 millimeters long; and the golden poison dart frog, one of the larger ones, measures 2.2 inches in length. Although all of the poison dart frogs are small, each one packs a powerful punch.



The poison dart frog is a lesson to all those who judge others according to their size. What these frogs lack in length, they definitely make up for in defensive ability. In fact, they are some of the most feared creatures in nature. Aren't you glad that God doesn't judge us according to our size and appearance? Think about David. He was considered a small boy, but he defeated a great big giant with just one stone! Don't let anyone tell you that you are too small or too weak to make a difference! God doesn't care about your size or your appearance. No matter who you are, He can use you to do great and mighty things for Him! ☺

The golden poison dart frog is the most dangerous. It carries enough poison to kill about 10-20 humans.



The strawberry poison dart frog can be found in 15-30 different color morphs.



The poison from a dyeing dart frog is used for hunting, but also is rubbed on the skin of young parrots, which causes their feathers to grow in different colors.

JUMPIN' AROUND

Move very carefully through this group of poison dart frogs to get to the finish. You may move up, down, left, or right (but not diagonally) to the next frog, but only if it is the same color or the same shape as the one you are on. Start at the red frog in the top left corner. From there, move through the maze, following the rules, until you end up at the yellow frog on the bottom row.

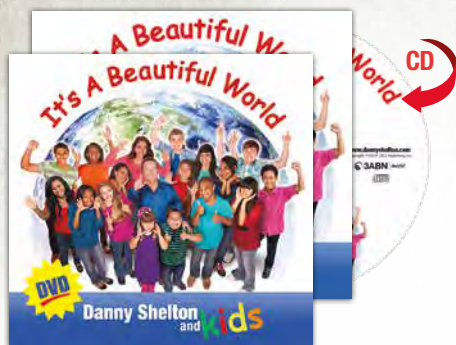

How Big Is HIS Hand?

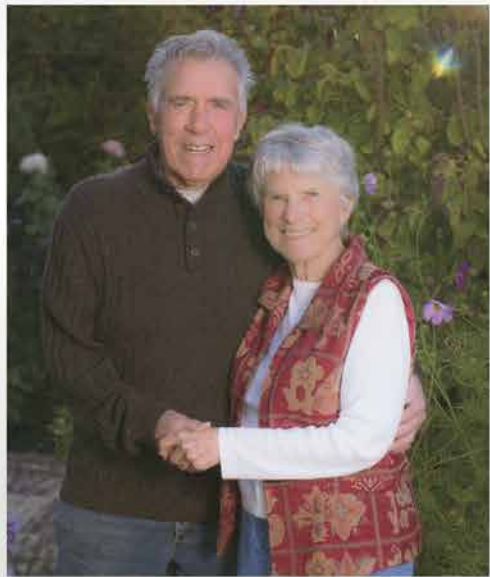

her shoes down with her. But instead of putting them on in the attic, she tried to carry them down, and with only one hand on the ladder, she fell back and hit her head.

"That day, she couldn't keep anything down, and the doctor's advice was to keep her quiet. But by the next morning she was back to her vibrant self. Then, ten days later, I was already at work when our little climber missed her footing getting down from the table and hit the back of her head, again. Still in her robe, my wife Toni carried her to our bed, then hurriedly put on clothing. Heidi threw up

and choked on her food, but Toni gave her mouth-to-mouth, and she started breathing again.

"Now the devil loves to kick you when you're down, and the car wouldn't start; but fortunately, it was a stick shift, and was parked on a slight hill. When they reached the doctor's office, he called for an ambulance right away to take Heidi to the best neurosurgeon in the Northwest.

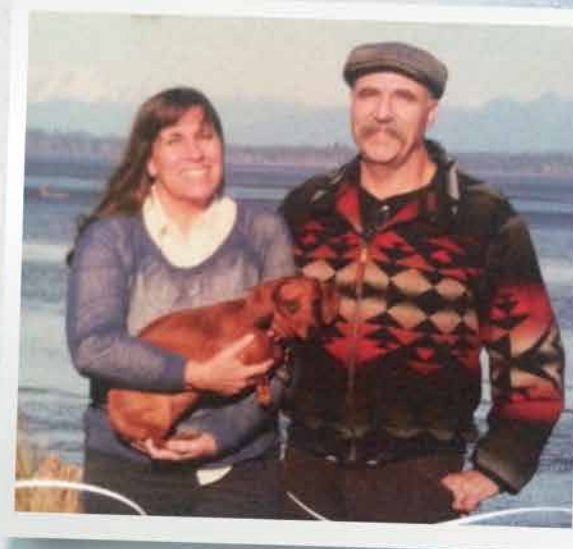

Minty Pea Soup

ingredients

- 1 cup onion, roughly chopped
- 3-4 cloves garlic, finely chopped or crushed
- 2 tsp oil
- 3 cups frozen peas
- 4 cups boiling water
- ¾ cup cashew nuts, raw
- 1 cup hot water
- 1 tsp salt
- ¼ cup fresh mint
- mint for garnish

directions

1. Sauté oil, onion, garlic in medium pot with high sides.
2. In a blender, blend cashew nuts and hot water until smooth and creamy.
3. Add frozen peas to pot. Add boiling water and cook for 5 minutes. Don't overcook or peas will go brown.
4. Add cashew cream to the soup and reserve a little for garnish.
5. Add salt and mint, then blend soup with a stick blender until smooth.
6. Serve with a garnish of mint, cashew cream, and the warm croutons on top.

WHOLEMEAL CROUTONS

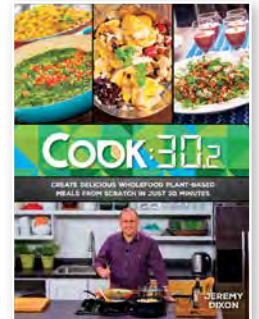
- 2 wholemeal buns or 4 wholemeal bread toast slices
- 1 tsp oil
- ¼ tsp salt

directions

Cut bread into ½-inch cubes and place on baking tray. Sprinkle salt over top and spray lightly with oil.

Bake at 300°F for around 5-7 minutes or until crispy on the outside, but not hard all the way through.

This is a lovely soup that is a favorite in my cafés. It's so easy to make, and has such a fresh flavor with the mint and the peas. The cashew cream is lovely, smooth, and creamy, and finishes this soup off perfectly. It's guaranteed to become one of your favorite recipes, and you'll make it time after time. CHEST PAIN

Last month I gave a brief introduction to pain. Remember, pain is an unpleasant stimulus that notifies the body that something is wrong, and if possible, it is important to identify the cause of the pain, since this makes treatment easier.

Sometimes the stimuli is interpreted by the nerves as pain; we call this nociceptive pain. The pain can also originate from the nerve, directly; we call this neuropathic pain.

But now let's focus on chest pain. Pain, discomfort, or an abnormal feeling happening suddenly above the waist needs to be evaluated immediately, since this symptom could be life-threatening. If someone punches you in the chest and you have pain, that's one thing. But life isn't usually that simple.

When I'm called to evaluate this kind of chest discomfort, pain, or an abnormal feeling above the waist, I first evaluate for these five conditions:

HEART ATTACK – Caused by an insufficient blood supply to heart muscle, this condition is life threatening and needs to be detected as soon as possible.

An electrocardiogram, blood work, and my patient's history help determine if this is the cause of pain. Remember, heart attacks are a leading cause of death and need immediate attention!

PULMONARY EMBOLISM – Caused usually by a blood clot traveling to the lungs, usually from the legs. More common in those who sit for prolonged periods of time, or are in a bed with illness or a recent procedure, a CT scan helps detect this life-threatening cause of chest pain.

AORTIC DISSECTION – Uncommon, but often fatal, this condition means the aorta is literally tearing apart. A CT scan or a transesophageal echocardiogram can make the diagnosis.

PNEMOTHORAX – Air leaking out of the lung can actually squish the lung. This condition needs immediate attention and a chest tube, or it may be fatal. An simple X-Ray of the chest can diagnose this condition.

UNSTABLE ANGINA – This pain comes from the heart, and needs to be diagnosed if it is the cause of the chest pain. A good history, blood work, an electrocardiogram, a stress test, or perhaps even an angiogram may be needed to properly evaluate for this potentially deadly cause of chest pain.

There are many other causes of chest pain, including acid reflux, esophageal problems, infections, shingles, musculo-skeletal problems, stress, gastrointestinal problems—the list goes on.

The important thing to remember is that a persistent pain or abnormal sensation above the waist needs to be evaluated. The symptom could be life-threatening and needs attention. If you have a sudden chest pain, or an

abnormal and unexplained sensation that will not go away, say a prayer, then call for help or dial 911!

If you have a specific question I can help you with, go to Heartwiseministries.org and I will do my best to help you. Next month I will discuss back pain, which is one of the major causes of chronic pain.

In closing, let's say a prayer right now for those in pain, remembering we have a Physician who will heal in His time, and in His way. ☺

Jeremiah 29:13

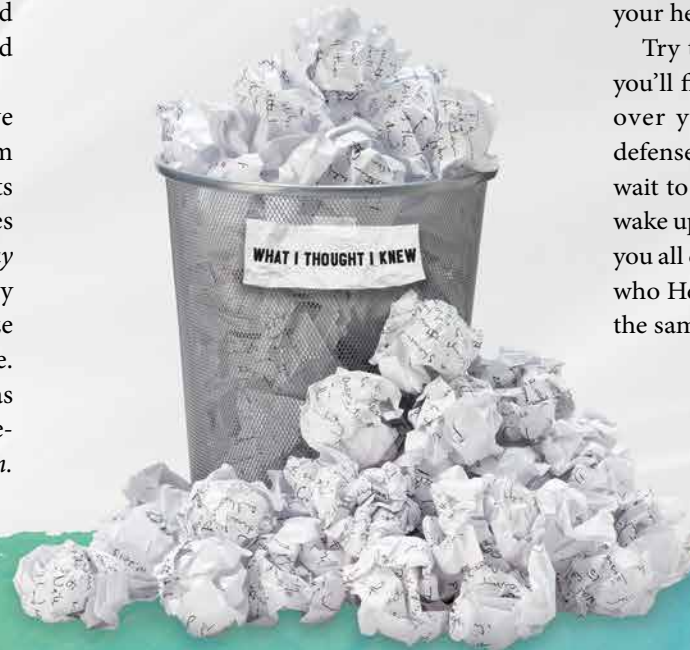
A Clean Slate

Back in the early 1980s I was dealing with some heavy issues in my life and was spending much time in the Word of God, searching for promises I could claim. As a consequence, Psalm 32 became a favorite, and remains a favorite to this day. While the entire psalm has a great message, verse 8 comes to mind quite often. "I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will guide you with My eye."

Over the last thirteen years, I have answered letters received from inmates here in 3ABN's Pastoral Ministries Department, and each time, I ask God as to how I should respond. important to lift up the name of Jesus in our responses. It's not about me, or 3ABN, but about God, who knows the end from the beginning, and who loves with an everlasting love.

Recharged With God's Joy

As an example of how God works in and through us, and how He provides divine appointments, I want to share a few excerpts from a young inmate's letter.

He writes, "I received your letter on February 17, my birthday. It came at the best time, as I had been put in confinement because someone threw their drugs next to me during a shake down. The night they placed me in confinement, I woke up and the books and your letter you sent me were there. God works through you to bring me inspiration

and encouragement every time I feel overcome by evil in this prison. Thank you for recharging me with God's joy!"

He continues, "I am reminded about what Paul wrote in Philippians 4:11, 'Not that I speak in regard to need, for I have learned in whatever state I am, to be content.' That is difficult for me to achieve, because when times get hard, I sometimes lose focus. But I'm also reminded of Romans 12:21, 'Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.'

"I am of good cheer, and I know that this too shall pass as I get out of prison on September 3, 2016. They took my 'good time' for this incident, but that does not bother me, because God has a plan. I have sixty days back here in the box, so I let you decide on something good for me to read. Christian testimonies cheer me up a lot."

Ask God for Appointments

Have you ever experienced what you thought was a "coincidence," only to realize later that it had been an act of God, or better yet, a divine appointment? It doesn't have to be a face-to-face encounter with someone. Perhaps it's a telephone call, or a letter, such as the young man's testimony above. I had no idea that his birthday was near at hand, or that he had a special need when I wrote him. *Thank you, Lord, for using me as a conduit!*

Why not ask God to give you a divine appointment very soon? It is exciting to know that God can use you! ☺

Jealousy and Judgment

Moses was led by God from Egypt into Midian where he worked as a shepherd, in preparation to lead the Israelites out of Egypt and through the desert. God also called his brother Aaron to be the high priest for His people, and his talented sister Miriam, who after crossing the Red Sea, was a prophetic voice leading the song of victory over the Egyptian army (Exodus 15).

Family Troubles

While the Israelites were camped in the desert, Moses' father-in-law, Jethro, brings his daughter Zipporah and her two sons to live with him. After observing Moses' heavy workload, Jethro counsels him to choose elders to help judge the matters brought by the people.

His counsel is confirmed when the Lord tells Moses to appoint seventy elders to help judge the people's problems. However, trouble brews and Miriam and Aaron rebel against Moses, apparently because they are not consulted or chosen when the elders are appointed.

In jealousy, they speak out against his wife, suggesting they believe Zipporah somehow influenced Moses' decision.

Ethnically a Midianite, Zipporah's skin is apparently darker than the Israelites, and in their disdain, they refer to her as the "Ethiopian woman." However, Zipporah is a descendant of Abraham, and a worshipper of the true God.

Outright Rebellion

The ringleader seems to be Miriam, since she is listed first, and the Hebrew verb is both feminine in gender and singular in number. However, Aaron apparently sympathizes with her, since he is named with her.

Their jealousy results in rebellion against God's appointed leader of His people, and their statements reveal the fact that they feel they are equal to Moses. "Has the

Lord indeed spoken only through Moses?" they ask. "Has He not spoken through us also?" Numbers 12:2.

Swift Judgment

Suddenly, the Lord commands Moses, Aaron, and Miriam, "Come out, you three, to the tabernacle of meeting!" Imagine the fear that gripped their hearts.

God then descends to the door of the tabernacle in a pillar of cloud, and calls Aaron and Miriam to step forward.

"I speak with him face to face, even plainly, and not in dark sayings," God says, "and he sees the form of the Lord. Why then were you not afraid to speak against My servant Moses?" As He asks this terrible question, the Lord's anger is aroused, and He swiftly departs.

Instantly, Miriam becomes leprous, as white as snow! When Aaron sees her condition, he begs Moses, "Please do not lay this sin on us, in which we have done foolishly and sinned."

Moses prays, asking the Lord to heal her, and the Lord answers, "Let her be shut out of the camp for seven days and then she can again return to the camp."

The Irony

Don't miss the irony! Miriam, who criticizes Moses' wife dark skin color, becomes white—with leprosy!

Once again, divine judgment and punishment appropriately fit the crime. Criticism against the one whom the Lord has chosen is clearly a serious sin, and something we should carefully consider, ourselves. However, we must note that in His great love and mercy, God uses leprosy to restore Miriam and Aaron back to Him. ☪
