After 18 years of broadcasting, our 3ABN Radio studios will be moving from our original uplink building to a new home, right here in our world headquarters. "We are in the process of designing and finalizing the plans, and soon construction will begin," says 3ABN Radio general manager, Jay Christian. "Our plans call for two new studios, several edit bays, and offices for our staff."

There are many advantages to the move. "We will have improved Internet connectivity, and since we're bringing our current equipment over, there is no large equipment investment," he explains. "Another advantage is that it's much simpler to have a 3ABN television guest simply walk down the hall for a radio interview the same day. God is blessing 3ABN Radio, and in January alone, we added three new radio stations. We're picking up fullpower FM stations, as well!

"From the beginning, 3ABN Radio has been inspired by God to reach people around the world with His message of love and eternal life. The future beckons, challenges, and excites us; and we humbly request your prayers and support. Together we will introduce even more people to our loving God."



WHAT IS THAT IN YOUR HAND?




