I was recently in Paradise, California, doing a follow-up program about last year's tragic fire that killed 85 people and destroyed over 18,000 structures. Most of the damage was done in about four hours as the fire spread at incredible speed of 80 football fields every 60 seconds! I spoke with many individuals who barely escaped with their lives.

One survivor told me that as the fire quickly overtook their neighborhood, they barely had time to escape their home. Putting a few items in their car, they hurriedly drove down the street. At this point of the story, they paused, and I could see the pain showing on their face. "I drove by one of my neighbor's homes, not realizing they needed someone to drive them to safety," they said,

"and unfortunately, they passed away that terrible day. I had room in my car for them as I drove out to safety—if I'd only known they needed help."

The Bible tells us that this earth will soon be destroyed by fire at Christ's Second Coming in 2 Peter 3:10, "But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up."

We know people all around us who are lost in sin, but we can help them find a way of escape through the saving grace of Jesus Christ. How sad it would be to get to Heaven and know we could have done more to reach those precious souls.



DARE TO DREAM— A Better Way to Live by Shelley Quinn

r. Yvonne Lewis (now Yvonne Shelton) arrived at 3ABN in 2010 to be interviewed, unaware God had a greater plan in store. As staff visited with her afterwards, it became apparent to all she possessed "3ABN DNA"—the special qualities we look for in hiring personnel—and was God's choice to spearhead an urban network we had struggled to launch. When we presented her the challenge, God poured His passion for the project into Yvonne's heart. She immediately began working to make the dream a reality, eventually moving to southern Illinois to join our staff.

A NETWORK IS BORN

3ABN Dare to Dream Network launched in January, 2011, with Yvonne serving as general manager. The network targets inner city residents with the gospel of Jesus Christ and practical tools for living, featuring programs that address the issues of crime, poverty, substance abuse, chronic health

concerns, and the erosion of the family unit, from a spiritual perspective.

From the time of her arrival, it was obvious Yvonne was a woman of prayer. She enlisted us as prayer partners for the urban outreach, and for her sons' return to Christ. God breathed life first into the network, and three years later, into her finally surrendered sons. When her younger son Jason accepted an invitation to visit 3ABN, he was—like his mother before him—completely unaware a first-time visit would be life-changing.

It was January, 2014, when Jason joined us for our Annual Day of Prayer—a time of devotion, reflection, and "vision casting" for the New Year. 3ABN founder, Danny Shelton, addressed staff and visitors, concluding, "If you leave this place and can't get it out of your mind, perhaps this is where God wants you to be." Those words would echo in Jason's mind—it was the call of God on his life!

A CLOSE CALL

Jason shares, "After attending college, I entered the hospitality industry, and worked seventy hours a week, managing a sports bar in Atlanta, Georgia. Seeking money and the party life, I enjoyed it all for a short time. But the mental and emotional pain that resulted wasn't worth it. A brush with the law, and facing a possible 15-year prison sentence on a drug charge, was a wake-up call.

"An unseen hand guided me through the aftermath, and I escaped the crushing consequences of the devil's clutches. Focused on staying out of trouble, I modified my behavior and altered my lifestyle, but still without the Lord. I had a deep emptiness within. I recognized my need of God. That's the starting point. If you don't realize you have a problem and need divine help, your life just keeps going in the same unhealthy circles. Suddenly, I reached a turning point—I had an urge to turn to God and serve Him, as my mother had taught me from childhood.

"After my first visit, I couldn't get 3ABN out of my mind. Danny's words pulled at me like nothing ever had before. I hate quitting a job, but I phoned Mom and told her I believed God was calling me to 3ABN. I submitted my resume, interviewed with Mollie Steenson, and was offered a job as Mom's greatly needed assistant. I resigned from my Atlanta job that paid twice as much, joined the 3ABN staff, and have never looked back."

Jason developed a personal devotional life, immersing himself daily in Bible study, and learning to depend upon God in prayer. He listened intently to the speakers and hosts on the Dare to Dream Network as he worked side-by-side with his mother to produce programs like Salvation in Symbols and Signs, Urban

Report, Dollars and Sen\$e, Take it to the Bank, Pure Choices, Pumped Up Parents, A Father's Heart, Workin' the Dream, Live to be Well, and Creative Cooking. Soon, he was hosting programs, involved in prison ministry, preaching at churches, and speaking at universities.

DARE TO DREAM - A BETTER WAY TO LIVE

In September of 2018, Jason Bradley assumed the position of General Manager for the Dare to Dream Network, which is available on YouTube, or on streaming devices such as Roku, Amazon Fire TV, and mySDAtv. Dare to Dream can also be viewed using our free 3ABN app on smartphones or tablets, and streamed from d2dnetwork.tv or Truli.com.

"My passion to show people a better way to live is generated by what the Lord did in my own life," Jason asserts. "He lifted me from the pit and put my feet on higher ground. People are hurting and searching for answers, and they need to know the basics of connecting personally with God and leading a fundamentally sound life. Dare to Dream exists to lead people to Christ, to provide resources that will empower them to break negative behavioral patterns, and uplift communities around the world."

Three Angels Broadcasting Network has been spreading joy for 35 years. The three angels' messages are full of good news for all who are looking for eternal life.

You can have a part in providing a smile, enthusiasm, and the desire to live forever with our Lord.

3ABN has several ways for you to help accomplish the mission of spreading the joy of meeting our Savior face-to-face. Here are a few ways for you to consider, and I know there are one or maybe two areas you will find attractive as a supporter of this ministry—especially when you

consider that you do not pay any legal fees for them.

Completing a Self-Administered Trust or a Will assures a portion or all of your estate will come to 3ABN only when both spouses have gone to sleep in the Lord. If you have not completed an estate document, then it is time to plan what happens to your estate, when the unthinkable happens. Remember, a well-planned estate is your best gift to God and family.

A Charitable Gift Annuity. Based on your age, a Charitable Gift Annuity is designed to give you a good interest rate and a monthly or quarterly fixed interest payment on the money you have invested. Payment is guaranteed for your life and your surviving spouse, if done together. When you and your surviving spouse pass away, the balance of the annuity comes directly to 3ABN. There are great tax benefits when you invest in this ministry, and it is irrevocable.

A Deferred Charitable Gift Annuity.

Check with our Planned Giving and Trust Services Department about a Charitable Gift Annuity based on your age. If your age doesn't allow for a good return now, then consider deferring your interest payment for several years to receive a better interest rate when interest payments begin.

A Revocable Cash Trust is another popular investment possibility for you to consider, and it operates separately from your Will or Trust. You can invest any amount after an initial deposit of \$10,000 or \$20,000, depending on whether you are an individual or you are including another person in the investment. You may include beneficiaries in this document; however, a 25 percent minimum must come to 3ABN—but only when you pass away. This investment is revocable, but does not allow for tax benefits.

An IRA Roll Over. If you are 70-and-a-half and you must take a required minimum distribution (RMD) from your IRA, then the U.S. Government allows you to donate from your IRA.

You can keep the amount that is required for you to take or you can donate it and any amount above what is coming to you—up to \$100,000, each calendar year.

To get the appropriate receipt, you must have your Financial Institution send the IRA donation directly to 3ABN. If it does not come directly from them, you may have to pay taxes on the amount taken from your IRA account. If the correct steps are taken, you don't have to report the withdrawal on your tax return as income.

ith a twinkle in his eye, Pastor Claude Turner pauses for a moment and asks, "Back in 1920, who would have thought I would live to be 100 years old? Truly, God had a plan I didn't know about at that time, but I'm grateful for His many blessings through the years, which included 75 years of happy married life with my wife Lois, and three wonderful children."

Born and raised in eastern Colorado by God-fearing parents, he says his uncle, John Turner, and the famed evangelist, H.M.S. Richards, held a country evangelistic series that resulted in the Seventh-day Adventist Church and school at Ford, Colorado. "That's where I attended elementary school, and later, I went to Campion Academy in

Loveland for high school. Then, in the summer of 1938, I decided to go door-to-door as a literature evangelist," he says. "I remember parking my bicycle and sitting on the bank of a ditch for morning worship one day, and dedicating my life to Jesus. Although I worked hard, by the end of the summer I'd only made a profit of \$30. But I didn't feel like a failure," he says.

His call to ministry came while he was a student at Union College in Nebraska, and after graduating, he was called to be a minister in the church he grew up in. Then, two years later, he became a Bible teacher at the

academy he attended—and that's when he was able to see the fruit of his earlier labor.

"I took a group of students on a seminar weekend, and I met a family that had purchased a Bible and some books from me," Pastor Turner says. "Then I found out that through those books, they'd become Seventh-day Adventists!"

His next call came from the Illinois Conference where he pastored several churches before becoming the Educational Secretary for all their church schools. "I also helped with the Little Grassy Lake Youth Camp in southern Illinois, and that's where I met Danny Shelton," he recalls. "Danny was a junior camper, and I never thought that someday there would be a 3ABN, or that I'd ever be part of their prayer ministry."

After 24 years in Illinois, Pastor Turner and his wife Lois moved to Loma Linda University in California, where she worked as a nurse and he worked as a chaplain. Then, in 2015, Lois passed away, and later, Claude became ill. "I remember the doctor asking me if I would consider spending the rest of my life on pain medication," he says, "and when I visited a retirement home to make arrangements, I looked around and saw a lot of old people. That's when I said to myself, *Oh no. Not*

yet! So I took a plane and visited my son David in Illinois, who had been a carpenter at 3ABN for about 30 years. While there, I visited 3ABN's Pastoral Department, and J.D. Quinn, the director, asked me if I'd like to go to work. My reply was 'Why not?' and that was two years ago. God restored my health and I feel fine. Thank you, Jesus!"

Pastor Turner has ministered on 3ABN's prayer line ever since, giving encouragement to those who need it, and receiving encouragement, too!

He recalls one experience when a retired nurse from Texas called several times, asking for prayer. "She didn't know what to do because she was facing dire financial hardship, so one day I told her I knew of a couple of ladies who were looking for caregivers here. She moved to southern Illinois and accepted one of those positions, and now she says it was a life-changing answer to prayer. She's now a member of our local church, and in her spare time, she volunteers in our Pastoral and Prison Ministry Department!

"During a recent camp meeting, a lady named Katie Thompson-Jones came up to me

and asked if I remembered her. She'd taken some Bible studies, and when I'd visited to urge her to get baptized, she said that *in a dream*, she'd been fighting with me! That seemed strange, but her interpretation was that the devil didn't want her to become a Christian. Sometime after that, I was honored to baptize her; and now, nearly 60 years later, she came back and blessed me with her story!

"I thank the Lord for all the great people who inspired me to help carry the gospel to the world," he concludes. "I want to encourage all to catch the same vision we have here at 3ABN. You may have very humble beginnings, but God wants to use you to help finish the work. Yes, life's journey has taken 100 years; but for me, it's not finished. Let's get busy. I want to live to see Jesus return!"

GREAT NEWS & Needs in Russia

Vour help makes all the difference, and recently, we received some great news from our 3ABN Russia executive manager, Julia Outkina. "3ABN Russia is carried full-time on two Russian satellites—Express AT 1 and AT 2—and part-time on eight other satellites and their foreign partners throughout our entire country," she says. "The monthly cost and technical-related expenses amount to approximately \$9,000 a month, and we're so very thankful for the family that has covered this expense, providing us an amazing opportunity for expansion! Because of this satellite coverage, we're now carried fulltime by 192 cable companies and their partners—and those are just the ones we know of! This means 3ABN Russia is now available in 1,518 big and small cities, towns, and villages, and at least two new cable companies are added to our list every week. We're also carried part-time on eight other satellites and their foreign partners, as well as on 42 regional TV stations. Just recently, we've also entered into contract relations with a big new TV content aggregator called Smotryoshka. What awesome opportunities the Lord has provided in the midst of difficult political times! For us, these are indicators that He approves of what we do and the programs we make to His honor and glory."

With this outstanding expansion, 3ABN Russia's audience is growing quickly, but their Call Center and Internet funds remain very limited. "Our Call Center currently consists of only one worker," Julia says, "and our budget for publishing and mailing hasn't grown for the past several years.

"The need to publish and send out new literature is very great, and we've been carefully conservative in our plans. Our approximate needs for the following year include \$3,000 for new booklets about our programs, \$1,000 for donation pamphlets, \$2,300 for our 3ABN Russia magazine, \$6,000 for our free children's Bible study course, and \$8,700 for Internet advertising of our children's books, recipe books, and literature about fighting addictions.

"In addition, our 3ABN Russia production crew has a huge dream of purchasing \$95,000 worth of LED panels for taping both in our studio and in our large sanctuary," Julia says. "We pray that the Lord will answer as He sees fit. We'll rejoice if He answers yes, and we'll humbly accept if He says no, because we realize how large this amount is. Either way, we continue to praise Him for His awesome blessings, guidance, and protection! Thank you so much, dear 3ABN family, for caring for the salvation of the Russian-speaking people of the world!"



INGREDIENTS

- 2 large eggplants
- ¼ cup of tahini
- juice of half a lemon
- 3 cloves of garlic
- 1 tsp of salt
- a few dashes of cayenne
- pita bread

GARNISH

- kalamata olives
- parsley
- other herbs
- olive oil tomatoes

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Roast eggplants whole on an open flame for 15-20 minutes, or until charred on the outside and soft on the inside.* Set aside to cool for a few minutes, then remove skin.
- 2. Using a fork, mash up eggplant to a chunky consistency, then add tahini, lemon juice, garlic, salt, and cayenne, mixing well. You may also use a food processor and pulse the mixture instead, but using a fork is a more authentic way to prepare it. If mixture is too thick, add a few tablespoons of water. Refrigerate the mixture.
- 3. (Optional) For crispy pita bread, cut it into small triangles, separate the joined pieces, and toast in oven until crispy.
- 4. Remove babaghanoush from the refrigerator, spread on a plate, drizzle olive oil and style as desired. Dip pita in the mixture, and enjoy!
- * If you do not want to cook on an open flame, you may roast the eggplant in the oven on the broil setting.
