At the beginning of 2023, Praise Him's new flagship program called *Praise Him* 

Now was released, and as we finish up our second season, we've highlighted many of our viewers' favorite artists, along with new and upcoming artists. We are currently recording our third season of *Praise Him Now*, which begins airing in January 2025. We will also begin airing other new programs in the upcoming year.

We already mentioned that it takes lots of help from skilled professionals to create 26 fresh new episodes each year, as well as maintaining and releasing new content for previously existing series. We are so blessed to have him on our side, helping to create some of the brightest and best-sounding music in the industry.

After the audio has been tuned and mixed, the recorded content is then sent on for video editing and finalization. This final process ends up with **Brandon Armstrong,** who makes everything you see on your screen look great!

Dee Hilderbrand has been with 3ABN now for 28 years, and it's fair to say that we've never known anyone who has more energy or a stronger desire to be helpful than this wonderful lady!

Raised in a churchgoing family, Dee remembers hearing about the love of Jesus at a young age. "I just wanted His love, so I went forward during an altar call with a sincere child's heart. That moment set the course for my life, and began a search that took me many places."

Her early life was very troubled. She left home at age 14, and after several years in foster care, she requested a judge for emancipation. He not only granted her request, but even apologized for the lack of care she had endured.

When she was 17, she finished high school while holding down a full-time job and renting her own apartment. She accomplished that by working as a cocktail waitress, a casino change girl, a hostess for a bus line, and modeling. Then she met her husband David and together they built several businesses.

But their boats, RV's, motorcycles, and money were not enough. Something was still missing.

While living in Portland, Oregon, they visited a Seventh-day Adventist Church and found a caring pastor just beginning a Bible study class. "As a teen, I'd felt like I was a bad person, and that I'd let God down," she says. "But now I realized that God loved me, and would accept my love, too! We joined the church, but were never firmly anchored; so when we moved, we drifted back to our secular lives. But God doesn't give up, and years later, we came back to church after selling our latest business and retiring in Grants Pass, Oregon. We became active in our church and discovered 3ABN—which we couldn't get enough of!

"Then, in 1995, David was diagnosed with non-Hodgkins lymphoma, and nine months later, he died in my arms," Dee says. "He's resting now in his grave, awaiting the Second Coming of Jesus, and I'm so grateful he died softly, without a struggle. Then, a few weeks later, I felt a deep assurance that I would see David in Heaven—and all I had to do was to make sure I was there, too."

### **Mending Broken People**

A few months later, Dee heard that 3ABN Founder, Danny Shelton, would be in the area. "I really wanted to meet him because of the impact 3ABN had on David and me," she says. "He invited me to visit 3ABN, and when I did, I was offered the position of Production Coordinator!

"3ABN might have needed me, but not nearly as much as I needed them. Honestly, I was grieving and so lost. I'd gone from 'us' to 'me,' and I didn't know who 'me' was. But God knew my heart, and when I committed it to Him as a child, He took it and said, 'Dee, someday you'll give me your life.' He kept me alive until I could do that, and I have my Aunt Vada and Aunt Velva to thank for it, because they prayed for me every day!

"When I arrived, no one knew what a new baby Christian I was. I was task-focused, not relationship-focused; and when I look back, I see how it was the people here who changed my life. Danny Shelton showed me what it meant to be true to my calling, and his wife Yvonne just loved me for who I was. Mollie Steenson, 3ABN's Vice President at the time, shared love and wisdom that helped me to survive. My co-workers helped me, too—like Cheryl Volsch, the Producer who stood by me, lifted me up, and wouldn't let me get away with anything I wasn't supposed to be doing. Kathy Dugger, who worked in Production, also stood by me—laughing with me and loving me when I needed it the most. And then there was Nikki Anderson in Radio, who was always there when I needed her.

"I made friends that will last for eternity—like Bobby Davis, Doug Garcia, and RobbieD Lauterjung, who all worked in Production. They were God's living witnesses to me, helping me see what a Christian walk looks like. And as younger

people came in, God gave me new friends like Kelly Peterson in accounting, Dara Badger in Radio, and Ian and Angela Vandervalk who just model leadership!

"And then there's my church family! Pastor John and Angela Lomacang have been wonderful mentors, as have Jeff and Charletta Doerr, John and Idalia Dinzey, Michael and Valera Babb, and Jeff and Jenni Poling. And where would I be without my friends Janice Chevalier and Pam Clark? Although I'm retired now, I still work part-time in the ministry; but God brought Curtis Badger to step into my old position because he has talents 3ABN needs now for its growth.

"This is a Mending Broken People Network—and it sure has mended me. I had a lot of emotional and psychological damage when I came here, but God used my co-workers to heal me. Today, I pray and believe that God is making me into the woman He always wanted me to be!"

Kay Anandasivam lives in Australia and recently attended 3ABN's School of Discipleship, where she shared her amazing testimony. "I was born and educated in Sri Lanka," Kay says, "and in 1997, a friend shared that we're all sinful and need Jesus. I'd been hearing about Him, so I said, 'I want to know Him. Show me who He is.'

"My friend directed me to a church, and as the pastor prayed for me, I saw a soft, red shawl cover me from head to toe. That moment, I felt all my sins were washed away! Jesus touched me, and since then, I've been following Him every day.

"Years later, everything was going well. I thought I was a good Christian because I went to church every Sunday, read my Bible, and prayed. I'd even gone on mission trips to the Philippines. But as I read Hebrews 4:7, I saw something I'd never seen before about God's Sabbath. I read, 'Again He designates a certain day, saying in David, "Today," after such a long time, as it has been said: "Today, if you will hear His voice, do not harden your hearts." There remains therefore a rest for the people of God.'

"That hit me hard, and I asked God, What is this? Then I read verse 11: 'Let us therefore be diligent to enter that rest, lest anyone fall according to the same example of disobedience,' and I said, God, I don't want to disobey You. I want to know."

Since the whole chapter talks about the Sabbath, Kay typed that word into YouTube and was flooded with videos from our 3ABN Sabbath School Panel as

comedian pauses to interact with his audience, passes a mic to a middle-aged man who he's learned is a music director, and asks him to sing a few lines. The man actually has a good voice and chooses "Amazing Grace." Then the comedian asks him to sing it again, "But this time, sing it as if your uncle just got out of jail, and that you've been healed from a gunshot wound and have a new lease on life." The words are the same, but the pathos, the expression, the inflection, the very soul of the song changes. The audience stands and explodes into applause.

When we live by our purpose, the pathos, the expression, the inflection, the soul of our lives dramatically change. So why do you live the way you do? Why do you eat what you eat? Is your lifestyle fueling your purpose, or is it a tangent side-dish you use to appease your cravings, likes, and dislikes?

Whether we are dealing with ourselves, or trying to help others live more healthfully, we often focus on the *what*—what we should change, what we should do, what we should eat. If only we can do the right thing, or get our kids to do the right thing, we feel all will be well.

Wrong. To quote Ellen White, living like that is to live like an automaton. In our health outreach efforts, what if we encouraged people to more clearly identify the *purpose?* Scripture says, "Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God" (1 Corinthians 10:31). *The glory of God* is a pur-

pose that supersedes physical strength, health, disease prevention, or avoiding suffering. God's glory is reflected in His handiwork. "The heavens declare the glory of God ..." (Psalm 19:1). Today, we focus mainly on gold, silver, platinum, diamonds, real jewelry, sterling silver, and gold and diamond watches," Bruce says, "and thanks to the generosity of our supporters, significant funds have been dedicated to spreading the three angels' messages. But the best part for me is that I've met beautiful people everywhere, and I've gotten to know them when I arrived to pick up their valuable donations. Many of them have stopped me before I left and given me even more donations. These wonderful Christians humbly walk with God and listen to His Holy Spirit, and we've all been blessed to witness their generosity and love. I love this ministry, and even though I'm retiring, I'll still be on call and come in on an as-needed basis."

"Bruce and Tammy Chance have done such a great job with the 3ABN Donation Center," says 3ABN President Greg Morikone. "They took an idea, and with God's blessing, made it a reality. As Bruce and Tammy retire, God already had a plan in place to keep our Donation Center going and growing; and since Addie Weesner has been working in this department for a while now, she is transitioning to be its new manager."

Jill Morikone, 3ABN Vice President/COO adds, "Bruce and Tammy have labored tirelessly in our Donation Center since its inception. What a tremendous difference their efforts have made to help spread the gospel through your donated items.
