

Dear 3ABN Family,



We are preparing for this year's coverage of the Generation. Youth. Christ. (GYC) Conference in Columbus, Ohio, where thousands of young people will gather for five days of worship, discipleship, and fellowship. Their theme this year is "Wherever He Goes"—a powerful call to follow the Lamb of God.

From morning to evening, participants immerse themselves in God's presence through prayer and worship, leaving worldly distractions behind. The intense earnestness of the Prayer Room strengthens their faith in God, as does the inspiring music and praise that are part of each program. Many say that GYC offers them a glimpse of Heaven, and the powerful

spiritual encounters they have spark a passion in their hearts for daily communion with God.

Fellowship is another important aspect of the conference as each participant has a chance to connect with like-minded Adventist young adults and build lasting friendships.

"One of the important aspects of GYC is the intentional 'afterglow' time that gives them time to connect with each other in a more meaningful way," says Pastor Park. "As they're surrounded by peers who understand their faith journey, they draw strength from their commitment to God."

But perhaps the most important aspect of this conference is that it offers each person a chance to discover new avenues to serve the Lord. They gain wisdom from experienced spiritual mentors on how to navigate life's challenges and enhance their biblical understanding, and the exhibit hall offers them many ways in which they can serve others.

or Andrés Iglesias and his wife Ana Salgas, the journey to 3ABN is a story of divine intervention, faith, and God's perfect timing. Both were raised in the Western Province of Pinar del Río, Cuba, and their lives have been shaped by their trust in God, from their roots in Cuba to their current roles at 3ABN Latino.

Ana was raised in the Seventh-day Adventist faith, along with her older brother Jaciel. Her father was a music professor, and her mother was a homemaker. Ana's early exposure led her to earn a degree in music, specializing in violin.

Andrés was raised by his mother and grandmother, and grew up without knowing his father until he was 15. During his second year of college, where he studied computer science, he was introduced to the Adventist church, sparking his spiritual journey.

A Love Story in Cuba

In 2008, Andrés and Ana's paths crossed in a significant way, when as he prepared to be baptized into the Adventist faith, Ana was invited to sing at his baptism. Although they had never spoken before that day, Andrés showed an interest in Ana. After hearing her sing, he began downloading and sharing background music for her to sing at church, which created opportunities for them to spend time together. This marked the beginning of their friendship, and their relationship blossomed, leading to their marriage five years later on Christmas Eve of 2013.

In search of better opportunities, the couple left Cuba for Ecuador when Andres was 28, and Ana was 21. Their journey then brought them to the United States, where they arrived in Florida in August 2015. How they got to the United States was nothing short of miraculous—a



The Call to 3ABN

While living in Florida, Andrés found work at a software company, but felt an emptiness he couldn't shake. "I felt a void that I could not fill," he recalls. "In my heart, I felt called to something different—to work for God. I longed for a more peaceful life in the country, and my concerns about city life and my desire to work for God grew stronger after the birth of our first son Christopher in 2017.

During this time, 3ABN Latino was a constant presence in their home. Andrés would leave the TV playing 3ABN Latino programs—even when they were not there.

One particular day, after enduring the usual long hours in traffic for a 15-mile commute, he arrived home just in time to hear Idalia Dinzey announce that 3ABN Latino was looking for video editors.

"What I found interesting is that at the precise moment I walked in the door, the first thing I heard was, 'We need video editors," Andres explains. "If I had walked in a second earlier or later, I wouldn't have heard the announcement. That day, God orchestrated everything—including the traffic and traffic lights—so I would arrive and hear those words at that precise moment!"

The very next day, Andrés sent 3ABN Latino an email with his résumé, expressing his desire to work for God. That moment of faith marked the beginning of their journey at 3ABN.

Andrés currently serves as Head Video Editor for the Spanish network. His chosen

converged in a way that fulfills him, both spiritually and professionally. "It is, without a doubt, one of the best things that has ever happened in my life," he says. "God has been so good to us since He brought us here."



their discipleship efforts.

"Our goal is for these followers of Christ to be 'set on fire' with the Holy Spirit," says 3ABN School of Discipleship Coordinator, Ryan Day. "We want them to burn so brightly that when they return, they'll start 'house fires' in their homes, 'church fires' in their churches, and 'community fires' where they live!

"Our students learn how to study their Bibles and dig deeply into the subject of the great controversy between God and Satan," he continues. "They study Church history and learn how to implement health ministry in their communities, too. This time, we're putting more emphasis on apologetics, providing extended training in the area of defending the faith, since they'll sometimes be confronted with difficult questions. We want them to be able to respond in a Christ-like manner, with the Bible as their only source of truth. There will also be more emphasis on evangelism, and we'll give them practical lessons on being a great witness when conducting Bible studies and having spiritual conversations with people.


"Each morning, we provide special training during our 'Early Will I Seek Him' time. We take a practical approach to prayer, then go into 3ABN's Worship Center to practice what we've learned. Each evening, our students can also get extra one-on-one time with their instructors to ask questions, pray with them, or seek spiritual advice."

Pastor James Rafferty, 3ABN's Director of Discipleship, says, "In 1985, I learned how to study the Bible, and that changed my life. In the same way, 3ABN SOD is an opportunity for those who attend to learn those same principles—and it's exciting to watch how it changes their lives, too!"

Assistant Coordinator, Ian Vandervalk, agrees. "There's something special about connecting and walking beside them on their journey," he says. "Each student comes with specific expectations, but God always surpasses those and gives

them so much more! Later, our greatest joy is to hear how God continues to work in their lives."

ershell Crippen's life is not easy, but he's grateful he found a wonderful relationship with Jesus.

"I didn't find the Lord until I was 'threescore-and-ten," he says. "That's when I found an old pastor called Arnold Murray who had a TV program called The Shepherd's Chapel. He was a Sabbath-keeper, but I didn't even know what the Sabbath was back then. After he passed away, I was surfing channels and found 3ABN. Lonnie Melashenko had dark hair back then, and Doug Batchelor looked like he was 20-something! But their sermons were Bible-based, and I was hooked. 3ABN backs up what they're saying with Scripture, and you can't get any truer than that!

"Then, I heard the Holy Spirit urging me to get baptized. So I talked to my Seventh-day Adventist pastor. I explained that I have some mental difficulties that keep me from

INGREDIENTS

- ½ cup brown sugar • 3 ripe plantains

 - 1 tsp cinnamon
- 1 tsp vanilla
- pinch of salt



DIRECTIONS

• 4 Tbsp oil

• 1 cup water

- 1. Cut plantains into 3-4 pieces, and then in half, lengthwise. Sauté them in oil, turning constantly, until brown on all sides.
- 2. In another sauté pan, add water and all other ingredients and bring to a boil.
- 3. When mixture thickens, add fried plantains, making sure they are fully cooked and caramelized before serving.
