
Then, a few weeks ago, we heard from a lady who lives in a multi-generational home with ten family members. They were Saturday Sabbath observers, but had never heard

he faith children display puts many of us adults to shame. They possess the ability to simply believe their parents won't let any harm come to them—no matter their fear of trying something new, like riding a bike, downhill skiing, or diving off the high dive. The unthinkable becomes reality because of their trust and love for their parents, dedicated teachers, and dependable adults in their lives.

I recall a time taking some kids to an outdoor camp and our encounter with

the Challenge Wall. It was at least three or four stories tall! The kids were excited and showed little fear going up. But I was content to remain on solid ground, encouraging them from below.

That lasted until the last child went up and all the kids ganged up on me, urging me to go up that Challenge Wall, myself. But no amount of convincing was going to work. Did I mistrust the camp officials? The equipment? What was I truly scared of? And what about the kids? What message would I be giving them by not going?

I simply couldn't let them down, but I'll admit I shook the whole way up—and screamed the whole way down, when I meant to be silent!

Faith in Jesus

Our new season of *Jesus My Light* programs is all about Jesus as the Master Healer. And what stands out to me is the fact that the healing people experienced was dependent on their faith—or even the faith of someone on their behalf.

I like to think of the story of the humble centurion who favored the Jews and even built them a synagogue. When Jesus came to Capernaum, he asked the city elders to ask Jesus to heal his servant. He had total faith in Him, yet while Jesus was walking to his home, he sent friends to say, "... 'I am not worthy that You should enter under my roof. ... But say the word, and my servant will be healed" (Luke 7:6–7).

Jesus' stunning response was, "... 'I have not found such great faith, not even in Israel!" (Luke 7:9). Neither the Jewish leaders nor the disciples, who knew the Scriptures, had that much faith!

In each miraculous healing, Jesus was far more concerned with deepening and strengthening the faith of those who would believe in God's love for them.

Growing in Faith

Are we like little children, eager to grow in our faith? They see answered prayers as God actively helping them grow and believe more in Jesus.

One of our young guests prayed for a couple of years to come here, although she lived in a faraway country, and her parents had no idea how they might be able to afford the trip. When her dream came true and she came to record with us, she couldn't contain her excitement!

We need to be like these children, with complete faith! We can't let our doubt and the storms of life darken our picture of God's love.

I think of when Jesus calmed the storm. His disciples were so overtaken with fear that they were convinced their boat would sink. With a flash of lightning, they saw their Savior, Whom they had forgotten was in the boat with them—and even then they had no faith!

Please consider that in every storm we encounter, what Jesus is concerned with is *increasing* our faith. Is our trust in God deepening and soaring to new heights? Per-

Talling INTO PLACE

otini Martinez works in our 3ABN Accounting Department, and her faith journey is a beautiful story of God's grace and guidance.

A Difficult Beginning

Fotini was born in Greece to a U.S. military father and a Greek mother. But as a young child, she and her brother spent two years with their grandparents, while their parents lived in Germany.

"We didn't speak Greek, and they didn't speak English," Fotini says, "and although Mom called often, I couldn't understand why she'd left us. But later, I learned that my alcoholic father had lost his job, and left for good."

Finally reunited with her mother, Fotini helped in her cleaning business, but after

graduating from technical school, she began working in a bar—and that's when her life took a sharp turn.

"I had little emotional attachment to anyone, but at the bar, people were friendly to this skinny 18-year-old blonde. They bought me drinks, coffee, and cigarettes, and gave me lots of tips. I guess if you're not spoon-fed love, you learn to lick it off a knife. It didn't feel right, but it made me happier than I was. And of course, once I got drunk, everything was great."

By 25, she was anorexic and living on coffee, alcohol, and cigarettes. Desperate for change, she took 300 euros and got on a train to find a fresh start.

"Right then, I quit smoking and drinking," Fotini says. "God reached down and just took those things away! Then I met and married an American soldier, moved to the U.S. and gave birth to Artemis. And shortly after, my husband was deployed.

"I panicked," she admits. "I'd never lived in the U.S. and didn't even have a driver's license. For a year, I never left home; then two major things happened: I learned Artemis was autistic, and my husband was diagnosed with schizophrenia. The next three years were a nightmare. He was physically abusive, and I became a prisoner in my home. So I focused on my daughter—until I was served divorce papers."

Forced to rebuild her life, Fotini found a job at Artemis' school, secured an apartment, bought a car, and earned her GED. Then she pursued higher education, earned a bachelor's degree, and began studying for her master's. "All this time, everything fell into place. But I never gave God any credit for it," she admits.

Artemis learned by watching things repeatedly, and Fotini was bothered by

the cartoons she watched. So she searched for Christian cartoons and then began watching Christian videos and listening to Christian music, herself.

Then COVID hit, schools closed, and she lost her job—only to find a better one. But homeschooling her daughter, a full-time job, and studying for her master's was too much.

"One day, I sat crying in my car before work and my phone rang. It was my mother, whom I hadn't spoken to in ten years. She had remarried and moved to Arizona, and it wasn't long before she was coming to visit me.

"But Mom had changed," Fotini says, "and one day, she asked, 'Have you heard of Seventh-day Adventists?' I said no, so she told me she'd attended a Revelation Seminar, gotten baptized, and was now a Seventh-day Adventist. She also told me about the Sabbath—and I loved the concept! God wanted me to rest? I was exhausted!"

A New Life

Fotini moved to Arizona, but because of COVID, Artemis attended church school using her laptop. "As I tried to help her learn about Jesus, I was learning, too, and that's when I realized that God had been guiding me all along," she says. "Even though things were crazy and stressful, everything kept falling into place. When I mentioned this to my mother, she said, 'Of course they did, Fotini! You had a whole church praying for you for ten years!'

"After my baptism on January 1, 2022, I got very active in church. I watched Pastor Doug Batchelor on YouTube, and it began suggesting 3ABN videos. Next, I saw a 3ABN job opening on Facebook, but since I honestly didn't know where 3ABN was, I was shocked when I got it!"

Where God Wants Us

"Without a doubt, this is where God wants us to be," Fotini says. "Artemis struggles with change. But she's just fine with a new home and a new school, and I just love my work, too."

"Several Bible verses summarize my experience," she concludes. "Matthew 5:45 says that God 'makes His sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust,' and now I realize I was blessed even before I knew the Lord!

"The Bible mentions intercessory prayer in 1 Timothy 2:1: 'Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men.' I know that God worked it all out because a whole church prayed for me!

"And finally, 2 Timothy 1:7 says, 'For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.' That's my favorite, because even when I didn't think about Him, He was thinking about me. I don't have to be afraid of anything because I have the most powerful Source on my side. He loves me, and gives me a sound and peaceful mind—and everything always falls into place."



Tawoona Ziegler tells us she grew up in a large family that attended church faithfully every week.

"Every Sabbath, we enjoyed church fellowship, and when I was about ten years old, I decided to get baptized," she says.

"But as I reached my teenage years, I definitely felt very anxious to get out into the world and see what it had to offer, and church became more of something we had to do because that's what our parents expected."

Drifting Away

As Tawoona grew older and got her driver's license, she began to be more independent, eventually choosing a different path.

"I wanted to do my own thing and mingle with as many people from the world as I could," she admits, "and on many weekends, I'd be out partying with my friends so late that I was too tired to go to church.

"That's how I drifted away. My focus was mainly on making money and acquiring things—a new house, a new car—but they just didn't satisfy me, and I'd always be shopping for something new."

Along the way, she began listening to the radio. "I was a big talk radio listener, and I found it very satisfying. But then COVID showed up and suddenly everything on talk radio was upsetting!

"One day," Tawoona continues, "I was at my hairdresser's when she said, 'Oh, I have 3ABN on. I can get 3ABN on my TV!' "I told her I'd never really watched it before, but I'd like to. Then I wondered how she had it on her TV since it wasn't a regular station or on cable.

"So she showed me the 3ABN+ app and told me I could get it on my phone. When I got home, I downloaded the app and started watching, and so many of the programs touched my heart."

Coming Back

As she listened, Tawoona realized it wasn't too late for her to come back to Jesus. "Even though I'm a sinner, God still loves me and wants me in His kingdom!" she says. 
