# PRESIDENT'S LETTER | Greg Morikone



Dear 3ABN Family,

The horizon was already thick with smoke when I received a message that a section of 3ABN's property was on fire—and that it was headed toward some of our buildings! In springtime, some of 3ABN's fields surrounding our main campus have dead, dry grass from the winter; and despite all the snow and rain we receive, it takes only a few days of low humidity and a good wind to dry things up to the point where things can easily catch fire.

One of our neighbors had started a small fire, and it quickly got out of control, spreading to the woods, and then our field. They had already

called the fire department before any of us arrived, and it wasn't long before they had quenched it.

Everything seemed under control, but late that evening, the wind picked up again and a smoldering spark once again turned into a fire that began spreading quickly! This time, it took several hours before the firemen were able to put it out completely, but again, no buildings were damaged.

That got me thinking, *Isn't it amazing* how one small ember can ignite a fire that spreads so fast?

I was reminded of James 3:6–8, where the Bible describes our tongue (or mouth) as a "fire" and a "world of iniquity." Have you noticed how fast damaging rumors and "juicy news" spreads about people and ministries? It starts with one word and spreads from there. Maybe that's why Psalm 141:3 says, "Set a guard, O Lord, over my mouth; keep watch over the door of my lips."

My prayer is that the words of my mouth will be quick to spread the gospel message that Jesus saves and that He's coming again very soon—and slow to repeat negativity and gossip.



# Remote Equipment Needs

ver time, television equipment becomes outdated and must be replaced. But technological advances usually offer more features and capabilities at a lower cost. This also applies to our "remote" equipment for smaller productions, where 3ABN production trucks are impractical.

Recently, we've begun replacing our outdated equipment with newer, more efficient equipment that delivers much better quality. "This equipment can do pretty much everything our production truck can, but on a smaller scale," says Jorge Jaque, 3ABN's Production Manager. "With it, we can produce live events that don't require nearly as much equipment—at the same or even better quality than what our television production truck delivers!"

Some of the programs we're using it for include those we'll broadcast from the General Conference (GC) Session this summer in St. Louis, Missouri, as well as other yearly events like the Adventist Medical Evangelism Ministry (AMEN) Conference, and interviews at the ASI Convention this summer in Orlando, Florida. In addition, we'll be using it to produce Christ-centered 3ABN content for social media, too.

# **Matching Funds**

"We need \$20,000 for this upgrade, and a generous husband and wife donor team offered to give \$10,000 as matching funds," says 3ABN President Greg Morikone. "We praise the Lord for their generosity, and wanted to let you know about it. We also wanted to thank you for your support as we seek to fulfill Jesus' Great Commission to spread the gospel to the world!"

Jorge adds that some of the funds we've received have already been used to buy part of the new equipment needed. "We've bought a computer, new 4K high-definition cameras that allow for live video transmission in remote shoots, video monitors, and updated audio equipment," he says. "However, we still need to purchase a 4K high-definition switcher and some additional equipment. Our goal is to consolidate all the parts and place them in three racks that can just be rolled in when we arrive and be pretty much ready to start production."

*utter makes the batter better.* That's what I picked up from a fast-repeated tongue twister as a kid. It's not necessarily that fat tastes irresistible by itself; it just seems to make everything else taste better. However, after our nation's public health mission in the 1980s to lower dietary fat intake, food manufacturers set to work figuring out how to create rich, creamy, and smooth low-fat products that still tasted good.

Emulsifiers are a category of food additives that could be classified as fake fats. An emulsifier is simply a substance that allows water and fat to remain mixed together—a texture changer. Common foods like low-fat mayonnaise, store-bought ice cream, processed cheese, some yogurts, cakes, breads, meat products, "reduced-fat" anything, and even non-dairy milks often contain emulsifiers to improve the mouthfeel and shelf life.

But there are a few problems with fake fat additives like emulsifiers. First of all, they are liars. They relay the stats on what we're eating to the brain via the taste buds, but the brain discerns the discrepancy. Tasted like, felt like, smelled like, but it cheated me. Research reveals that when the brain perceives a high fat item but

doesn't actually experience the reality of it once it hits the bloodstream, then cravings ensue—and the calories are made up for in some other way. It is a very interesting concept.

Another problem is that these emulsifiers are not digested and absorbed the way we digest and absorb fat. Many of those emulsifiers land in the large intestine in the midst of our microbial colony, where they can wreak havoc. Research has found that some alter the gut microbiota by reducing beneficial bacteria and increasing pro-inflammatory bacteria. Other studies have found that emulsifiers can promote conditions that lead to digestive symptoms, leaky gut, or even inflammatory bowel diseases.

There are over 100 different emulsifier options available to food manufacturers. Some, like lecithin, do not pose as much of a problem. But others, like carrageenan, carboxymethylcellulose, and various gums, are not so benign. Many are given harmless-sounding names to produce safe-looking ingredient lists. So it turns out that home cooking is the best way to "make the batter better."  $\$
